Marc Dubernet has 23 years' experience working as part of the French Development Agency's network. He was successively head of a department investigating the funding of social and intermediate real estate programmes (Reunion, 1989/1997), project manager in Central Africa in the urban development and infrastructure sectors (Gabon, 1997/2001), deputy director of an overseas office (Guadeloupe, 2001/2005), director of a regional office in West Africa (Guinea-Sierra Leone, 2005/2008), and finally director of the Reunion office (2010/2014).

He also spent six years at the French Development Agency's headquarters, where he was deputy head of a technical divisions specialising in support for financial systems and the private sector (2008/2010), then deputy executive director of operations with responsibility for a wide range of operational and organisational matters and processes.

Since 2018, working from Reunion, he has been overseeing the launch of the FDA's new regional department for the Indian Ocean, covering Reunion, Mayotte, Mauritius/Seychelles, Madagascar and Comoros.
