National Observatory of Coastal Cities and Ports (ONCP), is a new dialogue forum willing to bring together coastal cities in Mozambique, port authorities, academic entities, communities, researchers, civil society, national and international organizations for the benefit of an Integrated and Sustainable Urban Development to achieve the AIVP 2030 Agenda and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).



Focus

Advocacy, research, cooperation promotion for an integrated Urban and Port development, dialogue between cities, central government with Port authorities, environmental ports development promotion, cooperation between Port authorities, academics, environmental and social organizations.



Main Challenges

- Absence of a permanent dialogue between cities and Ports;
- Lack of a forum to bring together all stakeholders and seek consensus for an integrated urban development strategies;
- Absence of a legal regulation to rule the roll of each intervenient on this matter (currently depends on the goodwill of those are in position in each mandate);
- Absence of a national entity to promote research, dialogue, to advocate for a sustainable and integrated development of Ports and Coastal cities in the context of climate change;
